Subject: Homicide Investigation – Suspect Arrested

Suspect: Vicente Munoz, age 28, of Indio, CA

Anonymous Information: Coachella Valley Crime Stoppers 341-STOP (7867) "See Something Say Something"

On Saturday, March 14, 2020, about 12:55 A.M., Indio Police Officers responded to a report of a fight between two males on Jefferson Street and Highway 111.

Upon arrival of the location, the officers found a adult male at the Circle K store, 79-900 block of HVVY 111, lying on the ground in front of the store. Officers discovered that the victim was stabbed and Indio Fire/Rivco.Cal Fire ambulance transported the victim to the hospital for his injuries. The victim later passed away at the hospital.

Indio Police detectives assumed the investigation and determined based on evidence and information developed, identified a suspect as Vicente Munoz. At about 11:00 A.M. today suspect Munoz was located at Fred Waring Drive and Adams Street without incident, in the City of La Quinta. Based on the investigation results, Indio Police detectives booked Vicente Munoz at the Riverside County Jail in Indio for charges of murder and parole violation. See attach booking photo.
